**Scott Brown** is currently the Assistant Band Director at Dickerson Middle School and serves on the instructional staff at Lassiter High School. In addition, Mr. Brown is co-founder and director of the North Georgia Percussion Camp. Mr. Brown is co-author of "Field Level - The Ultimate Band Director's Guide to fielding the Ultimate Marching Percussion Section" published by Row-Loff Productions and has had articles published in Percussive Notes Magazine, School Band & Orchestra Magazine, and Halftime Magazine. Scott has presented clinics for The Midwest Clinic, the Percussive Arts Society International Convention, the Georgia Music Educator's Association Conference, the Texas Bandmasters Association, and marching and concert percussion clinics in the Netherlands, Belgium, and Germany. As an adjudicator, Mr. Brown has judged competitions throughout the world including the DCA World Championships in Rochester, NY; the European Open Championships in Roeselare, Belgium; the World Music Contest in Kerkrade, The Netherlands, and the Thailand National Championships in Bangkok, Thailand. Scott is a graduate of Western Carolina University and alumnus of Carolina Crown Drum & Bugle Corps. He is an educational artist for Vic Firth, Mapex/Majestic Percussion, Sabian Cymbals, Row-Loff Productions, and Evans Drumheads.

**Travis Downs**, former Assistant Band Director at Tapp Middle School in Cobb County, was selected to be a Yamaha Artist/Clinician in 2001 and is a member of the Vic Firth Educational Team. Mr. Downs is currently the Assistant Band Director at Valdosta Middle School in Valdosta, GA and has taught percussion ensembles at the middle school, high school, and college level. He has also served on many percussion staffs, ranging from DCI, WGI, BOA, and many college summer camps. Mr. Downs is a very active clinician, arranger, and adjudicator throughout the southeast and has had various ensembles perform at state conferences and at the prestigious Midwest Clinic.

**Mike Lynch** has 26 years of public school teaching experience and is currently the Director of Percussion Studies at Lassiter High School and Assistant Band Director at Simpson Middle School in Marietta, GA. Mr. Lynch's drumlines and percussion ensembles have performed at the Georgia Music Educator's Association Conference on 6 different occasions, the BOA National Percussion Festival on 3 occasions, the Percussive Arts Society International Convention, and The Midwest Clinic. While he has been the percussion instructor at Lassiter, the Lassiter "Trojan" Marching Band has won the 1998 & 2002 Bands of America (BOA) Grand National Championships and 8 BOA Regional Championships. The band also participated in the 1999 & 2004 Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade in New York City and the 2001 & 2005 Tournament of Roses Parade in Pasadena, California. He on staff with the NFL Atlanta Falcons Drumline which performs at home games and other functions. Mr. Lynch is the co-author of "Field Level", "The Rudimental Cookbook", and "Just Desserts" all published by Row-Loff Productions. He has had articles published in the Georgia Percussive Arts Society Newsletter, Halftime Magazine, and Percussive Notes Magazine. Mr. Lynch is a member of the educational teams for Mapex/Majestic, Remo, Vic Firth, and Zildjian.
